

### Breakfast Pizza

Baking temperature: 375 degrees

Baking time: 20-30 minutes

- 1 lb. pork sausage
- 1 pg. (8 oz.) refrigerated crescent roll dough
- 1 ½ cups frozen loose-packed hash browns
- 1 cup Cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 cup Swiss cheese, shredded
- 5 eggs
- ¼ cup milk
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon pepper
- 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese

Fry pork sausage, drain and set aside. Unroll crescent rolls and separate. Place on a 12-inch pizza pan with points toward the center. Press together on the bottom and sides of the pan, sealing perforations to form a crust. Layer fried sausage, hash browns, Cheddar cheese and Swiss cheese over crescent roll dough. Beat eggs, milk, salt and pepper. Pour egg mixture over sausage, hash browns and cheeses. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese, then bake.

Add any other favorite toppings, such as mushrooms, green peppers, onions, etc. before eggs.

*Energy-saving tip: Turn off your oven several minutes before the Breakfast Pizza's full cooking time has finished. It will retain enough heat to cook the pizza thoroughly and you'll save energy.*

## Protect Your Electronic Equipment

Today's home computers and other sophisticated electronics are a great convenience to the homeowner. Along with the benefits, however, comes the potential for surges, spikes and sags — power quality issues that can cause serious damage to equipment.

UPPCO strives to provide electricity of consistent quality, but unexpected events may still occur from time to time. The best way to protect your equipment is by preventing uneven voltage from ever reaching it.

### Surge protectors and suppressors

These devices protect electronics from power surges and voltage spikes by either blocking or shorting to ground any voltage above a safe threshold. You can choose to protect your entire house at the point where power enters, or you can protect individual pieces.

### What to look for when buying surge protectors:

- **Match the protector/suppressor to the equipment** – Even though they may look similar, all surge protection is not created equal. For example, a surge protector that's perfect for a big-screen TV may not adequately protect a computer. Make sure you're choosing the right equipment for the job.

- **Warranty** – In many cases, the manufacturers of surge protectors offer warranties if the surge protector fails on any of the connected equipment.

If you own and use sensitive electronic equipment, consider also adding them to your insurance policy to assure their replacement if they would be damaged due to power quality problems.

If you use little to no electricity during the winter months, you can now choose to receive **only six bills**, from May through October, instead of 12 monthly bills during the year.

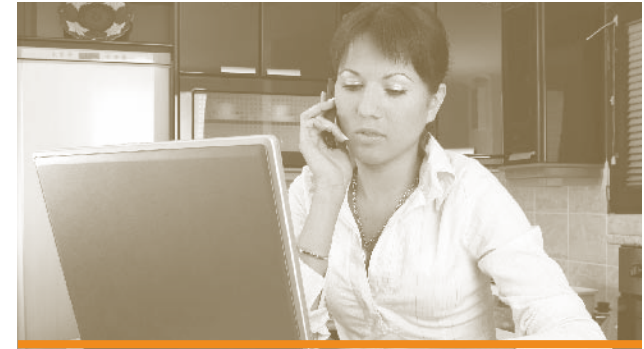
