## **UPPCO Planned Outage for Gwinn Area Saturday**

Ishpeming – Upper Peninsula Power Company will have a planned outage to its customers in the Gwinn area on Saturday, October 11 from 2 a.m. to approximately 5 a.m. ET. In particular, the outage will affect UPPCO customers in Gwinn and Little Lake and parts of Skandia and Richmond Township. Customers at Sawyer will not be affected.

The scheduled outage is necessary in order to perform needed work on American Transmission Company equipment at the UPPCO Gwinn substation to improve reliability.

“We realize that even scheduled outages are inconvenient, however this work will help UPPCO continue providing safe and reliable electric service to its customers,” said Steve Lillie, customer service manager. “This work can’t be done safely with the substation energized, so we timed the outage for the early morning hours to help minimize inconvenience to our customers.”
