UPPCO Donated \$107,917 to U.P. Charitable Causes in 2015

Marquette – Upper Peninsula Power Company (UPPCO) provided direct grants and volunteer support valued at \$107,917 to non-profit organizations, associations and other worthwhile causes located with the utility’s service territory spanning 10 U.P. counties in 2015.

UPPCO contributions were made in five primary categories: Arts and Culture; Community and Neighborhood Development; Education; Environment; and, Human Services and Health.

Outside of these categories, UPPCO teamed up with its employees to provide \$43,097 alone to the 2015 United Way Campaign. The company also gave \$2,665 worth of grants to charities that UPPCO employees and retirees volunteered their time for last year.
