D D D	<p><b>TERMS OF PAYMENT:</b> Bills are due in 21 days from date of bill. A delayed payment charge of 2% may be applied to the unpaid balance if the bill is not paid in full on or before the due date thereon.</p>	
<p><b>CONTRACT:</b> Minimum period of three years subject to automatic renewal periods of one year each. The contract may be terminated at the end of any yearly period upon 90 days written notice by either party. If the contract is terminated before the three year period, the customer may be responsible for the lesser of the cost of removal or the remaining monthly charges.</p>		
<p><b>RULES APPLYING:</b> Service is governed by the Company's Standard Rules and Regulations.</p>
