UPPCO Outage Restoration Completed Wednesday

Customers Urged to Call with any Questions or if they Need Assistance

- Upper Peninsula Power Company crews and contractors completed storm restoration efforts Wednesday night.
- All previous customer outages from Monday through last night are considered back in service. However, anyone still without power, other than those customers still waiting for repairs to their meter equipment, should call UPPCO at 800.562.7680 if they are still experiencing service issues.
- During the storm, trees or limbs may have fallen on service lines to a customer's home or business, possibly damaging electric service equipment such as meters and masts. If this occurred, UPPCO will inform you that your equipment is damaged. Please be aware that UPPCO cannot reattach the service line until damaged equipment is repaired and checked by a licensed electrician. This is for safety reasons. - People living in areas hardest hit by the storm should be on guard for trees that may be leaning or hung up on other trees and having the potential to fall, including on utility lines. Stay away from downed power lines that still may be present, especially with the recent snowfall melting. Report downed lines and any trees that could pose a threat to UPPCO.
