UPPCO Storm Update

- UPPCO crews and contractors completed restoration efforts at approximately 3:00 a.m. this morning. UPPCO believes all customers affected by Tuesday's storm have now been restored. Any customer that is still without power is being asked to report the outage by calling 800.562.7680. Customers can also utilize UPPCO's Online Portal at www.uppco.com to report outages.
- People should be on guard for trees that may be leaning or have the potential to fall. People are reminded to avoid and report all downed power lines and any trees that may pose a threat to UPPCO's distribution system.
- During the storm, trees or limbs may have fallen on to service lines that connect to a customer's home or business, possibly damaging electric service equipment such as meters and masts. If this occurred, UPPCO will inform you that your equipment is damaged. Please be aware that UPPCO cannot reattach the service line until the damaged equipment is repaired and checked by a licensed electrician. You can learn more at:
